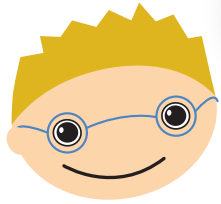




How to Be Safe in and Around Cars



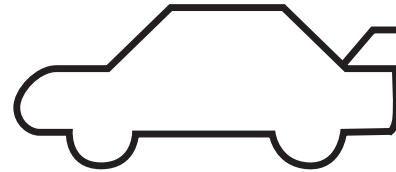
"Drivers of SUVs and trucks have less visibility when backing up. Most backover deaths occur in the driveway or parking lot."



Hyperthermia: A child's body can heat-up five times faster than an adult's body. Never leave a child unattended in a car, no matter what the temperature.

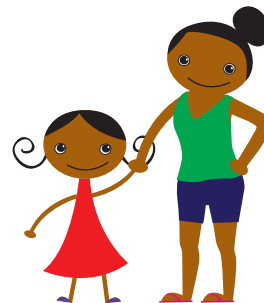
Is your child in the car? Look before you lock.



Show your children how to find the emergency trunk release and always lock your doors and trunk when leaving the car.



Store keys out of a child's reach and never allow your child to play in a car. Cars are not toys!
